7. Explanation of the Change:

Accreditation standards through the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) for the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program requires the distinction of doctoral level clinical hours

to meet criteria in the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN) DNP Essentials (2006). The proposed addition of 3 credits of NURS 875: DNP Intensive will meet this requirement. NURS 626: Research in Nursing and Healthcare has been removed from the program requirements. Upon a thorough review, the faculty concurred that NURS 626 content was duplicated in both NURS 850: Philosophical and Theoretical Foundations for Evidence Based Care and NURS 855: Translational Research in Healthcare.
