## 7. Explanation of the Change:

CD 600 Orientation to Community Development Study will change from a 2 to 3 credit course. In addition, the revised title will be Foundations of Community Development. With an increase of one credit to the required core, Option A and Option B were adjusted to maintain the 36 credit requirement for the program. The total credit hours required for Option C was reduced from 40 to 36 credits. This program is offered through the Great Plains Interactive Distance Education Alliance. The total credits required for the specialization were aligned with requirements at the partner universities (i.e., UNL, NDSU, KSU and ISU).
