Subject: Pre-requisite change for CSc 317

Gentlemen,

I have a request to change pre-requisites for the CSc 317 common course. We no longer require EE 245 and have replaced the course with CSc 244/244L and this presents a pre-requisite problem. I have been informed that BOR is looking down on different pre-requisites from different schools, so we are proposing that the new pre-requisite to CSc 317 be changed to CSC 314. All three schools currently have different pre-requisites and this would solve the problem.

Both Mines and DSU require CSc 314 currently, but Mines includes CSc 251 which is not taught at SDSU or DSU. SDSU currently requires EE 245/245L, but we no longer offer the course to CSc majors.

So, if we can all agree on CSc 314 ("C" of better), I will get the paperwork finished.
