7. Explanation of the Change:

In an effort to further align the Family & Consumer Science Education program with new secondary education curriculum, the SEED 456 Capstone/Action Research 1 credit course is being added to provide a culminating senior experience (capstone) in the same semester as EDFN 454 Teaching & Learning IV.

The College of Education & Human Sciences will replace EHS 309 Interdisciplinary Group Processes (2 cr.) with EHS 319 Life, Love, and Money (2 cr.).
