• a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
• 6+ credits of Modern Foreign Language coursework, including completion of the 202-Level
• a minimum of 12 credits from the Global Studies Electives Lists in World Cultures/ Societies, World Economics/ Geography, or World History/ Politics; 2 different prefixes minimum; No more than 6 credits per prefix; No more than 3 credits of lower division (100- and 200-level) coursework
