Proposed Curriculum (highlight changes)

7. Explanation of the Change:

Add HLTH 220 – Social Determinants of Health. This is a new course that focuses on conditions in which people are born, grow, work, live and age and how it may affect health and longevity. It is appropriate for all majors that have an interest in health and working with people.

Add HLTH 479 – Health Promotion Program and Evaluation. This course focuses on planning, implementing and evaluating health education/promotion programs through the use of various models.

Remove HDFS 250 – Development of Human Sexuality, HLTH 230 – Stress Management for Life, HLTH 250-250L – Pre-Professional First Aid and CPR & Lab and HLTH 364 – Emergency Medical Technician & Lab to elective credits. Students are to select one course from the list that best represents an area of additional study needed.

Students are required to have a minimum of 18 credits from the identified courses to obtain the minor.
