- Upper Division Major Electives: 18 credits (Max 6 non-HIST)
  - Select 12 credits from the following.
    - 300-400 level History Electives, GEOG 372-372L or GEOG 383-383L, GEOG 405, HIST 494 (max 3 credits)
    - One course must be HIST 349, HIST 368, HIST 410, HIST 411 or HIST 416.
  - Select 6 credits from the following
    - 300-400 level World History Electives, POLS 447, POLS 458
- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major
- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course – AIS 211 for teaching specialization students only
- a grade of C or better is required in SPCM 101, ENGL 101, SGR #5 Mathematics, and in all education coursework
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- 6+ credits of Modern Foreign Language coursework, including completion of the 202-Level
