Comments/Notes

The RN Upward Mobility option is designed as a degree completion for RNs who have completed a diploma or Associate's Degree nursing program. To be considered for admission, students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, no more than 3 SGR, College of Nursing requirements, or elective courses remaining, evidence of personal liability insurance, and an unencumbered nursing license. The College of Nursing also requires a grade of "C" or higher in all coursework applied toward graduation.

Applications to the RN Upward Mobility option are accepted three times a year (January, May, and August). Nursing major coursework can be completed in 3 or 5 semesters.
