- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in their major
- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course - AHSS 111 (or AIS 211 for teaching specializations students only)
- minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- a grade of C or better required in all major coursework

Spanish Major Technical Elective Credits: 21

- 21 credits total are required from the following 3 elective categories; distribution will vary for the Humanities and Professional Emphasis
- 15 of the 21 elective credits must be at the 300 and 400 level
- In total, 24 of the 36 credits required for the Spanish major must be at the 300 and 400 level
