This course provides the opportunity for students to build on basic skills of individual health assessment and apply those skills to their respective practices. It includes assessment of physiological and psychosocial processes relevant to the health of all age groups, and the assessment of selected human pathologies. The course focuses on mastering advanced physical assessment skills for use in formulating plans for education of students or developing quality improvement plans for patient-centered care.

Students in these roles do not need the practice content depth of diagnosis and treatment/prescription needed by the nurse practitioner students who enroll in NURS 631 (4 cr.), therefore, it is relevant to offer a course more specifically tailored to meet the content needs of the nurse educator and clinical nurse leader. NURS 630 course content is specific to advanced physical assessment knowledge needed by the nurse educator who will teach in the clinical and/or academic setting.
