MATH 101	Intermediate Algebra	3

Course Description
Basic properties of real numbers, linear equations and inequalities, quadratic equations, systems of equations, polynomials and factoring, rational expressions and equations, and radical expressions and equations, and an introduction to functions such as polynomial, exponential and logarithmic functions. Credit for MATH 101 will not be granted to anyone who has previously received credit for MATH 114 or MATH 115. A grade of S or a grade of C or better will be required for progression into MATH 114.

**Section 2. Modification(s) Requested**

2.1. This modification will include:

**Course Content/Description change (write proposed new content/description below)**

This course includes basic properties of real numbers. Topics generally include linear equations and inequalities, quadratic equations, systems of equations, polynomials and factoring, rational expressions and equations, radical expressions and equations, and an introduction to functions. Credit for MATH 101 will not be granted to anyone who has

previously received credit for MATH 114 or MATH 115. A grade of S or a grade of C or better will be required for progression into MATH 114.

**Effective term of the change:** Fall 2019

**2.2. Add justification for all changes noted above:**

Several common MATH course descriptions had not been updated in recent memory, including this one. The Math Discipline Council arrived at the proposed new description after discussion. It more accurately reflects the course content as it is currently delivered across the system.
