Students must earn a grade of “C” or better in FIN 310 Business Finance, MGMT 360 Organization and Management, HRM 460 Human Resource Management, and CSC/MGMT 325 Management Information Systems.

As part of the College of Agriculture, Food, and Environmental Sciences (CAFES), students in the program must complete 11 credits of Group I electives (3 of the 11 credits come from AGECE 354).

If a student chooses to double major in two majors offered through the Ness School of Management and Economics (Economics, Agricultural Business, Business Economics and Entrepreneurial Studies), the second major needs to have at least 18 credits that are distinct from the first major.
