Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.

*As part of the music major, students in this program must demonstrate piano proficiency. Students complete four semesters of class piano or take a proficiency exam within the first year of course work. Piano proficiency must be completed by their junior year in order to proceed to upper level applied lessons.

As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major (student teaching)
- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course AHSS 111
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- a "C" or better in each major course (MUS, MUEN, MUAP)
- 6+ credits of Modern Foreign Language coursework, including completion of the 202-Level

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
