No course currently exists. The University of South Dakota does have a clinical supervision training and ethics class (COUN 770), but it does not address case consultation. This course is designed as a curricular component of the Rehabilitation Counseling specialization, which is one of the nationally accredited Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) programs.
