Rehabilation Counseling Specialization CIP Code

Current CIP Code: <u>51.1508</u>; Title: Mental Health Counseling/Counselor.

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to provide evaluations, referrals, and short-term counseling services to help people prevent or remediate personal problems, conflicts, and emotional crises. Includes instruction in human development, psychopathology, individual and group counseling, personality theory, career assessment, patient screening and referral, observation and testing techniques, interviewing skills, professional standards and ethics, and applicable laws and regulations.

Proposed CIP Code: <u>51.2310</u>; Title: Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling/Counselor.

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to counsel and assist disabled individuals and recovering patients in order to achieve their greatest physical, mental, social, educational, and vocational potential. Includes instruction in patient evaluation and testing, rehabilitation program planning, patient support services and referral, job analysis, adjustment psychology, rehabilitation services provision, patient counseling and education, applicable law and regulations, and professional standards and ethics.

7. Explanation of the Change:

The accreditation body, the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) is requiring accredited programs to require 60 credit hour graduate degrees

by 2023. A merger between CACREP and Council on Rehabilitation Education (CORE) has created new standards and the curriculum above is designed to meet those standards.

The title of the specialization will be changed from Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling to Rehabilitation Counseling. The Department also offers a Clinical Mental Health Counseling specialization within the M.S. in Counseling and Human Resource Development. The similar titles have been confusing when referring to the two specializations. In addition, the changes requested to update the CIP code will more accurately reflect the nature of the specialization.
