The instructional method has been revised from *R – Lecture* to *A – Studio* to better reflect the nature of the course and the significant level of one-to-one interactions, and extensive hands-on student engagement. Additional modifications include 1) revised course prerequisites, 2) credit hours, and 3) course title. The course title has been modified to better fit with course content. In order to incorporate new courses in the curriculum and maintain the 120 credit hours for the major the credit hours for ID 212 have been reduced from 3 to 2 credits.
