2.2. Add justification for all changes noted above:

This modification addresses three changes to ID 377-377L.

- 1) The instructional method has been revised from R-Lecture to A-Studio to better reflect the nature of the course and the significant level of one-to-one interactions, and extensive hands-on student engagement.
- 2) The lab has also been eliminated. A number of labs have been eliminated from the curriculum (215L, 216L, 314L, 318L, 377L, and 415L). These are being removed as ID professors have found lecture time to be sufficient for instruction and students are able to

- meet the learning outcomes within the lecture time. This change has been completed to alleviate workload needs.
- 3) The course title has been adjusted to better reflect the professional curriculum and appeal to wider audience. The title also clarifies the content of the course.
