### 7. Explanation of the Change:

The Psychology curriculum has been revised to decrease the number of required courses to allow students more opportunity to focus their major on the courses they want for their final career of interest, while still obtaining a broad exposure to the field as a whole.

There have been changes in the SD DOE certification rules that impact the teacher education curriculum. The requirement for Human Relations has been replaced with an Adolescent Development requirement because of secondary certification moving down to 5th grade and elementary certification through 8th grade; there is no longer a middle grades certification. Currently the TLL faculty added adolescent development concepts to the existing human relations course but that is not the best way to deliver the content. EDFN 475 Human Relations (3 cr.) will be replaced by EDFN 340 Adolescent Development in Educational Contexts (3 cr.).

In addition, for ease of student transfers to teaching majors, course scheduling, and workload distribution, the Department of Teaching, Learning and Leadership is moving away from the large 7 bock for EDFN 453-453L to have EDFN 453 be a 3 credit course and with a 4 credit lab.
