#### 7. Explanation of the Change:

The following changes were identified for the Ranch Management minor:

- The required coursework was reduced from 15 to 9 credits and the electives increased from 3 to 9 credits to allow more flexibility in the electives selected by students.
- AGEC 471 Advanced Farm and Ranch Management will be offered as an alternative to AGEC 271 as a required course.
- RANG 374-374L Habitat Conservation and Management and Lab will increase from 3 to 4
  credit hours to better meet Student Learning Outcomes. This course has realigned from a
  required course to an elective course for the minor. Additional AGEC and RANG courses will
  be offered in the electives section to offer more flexibility for students to obtain the Ranch
  Management minor.
