7. Explanation of the Change:

The Department of Architecture are making the changes to the Master's program to be in alignment with changes made in the undergraduate program and to accommodate multiple student pathways through the degree.

The following changes were identified:

- Two topical design studios were deleted from the curriculum, ARCH 651 Professional Design Practice I (6 cr.) and ARCH 652 Professional Design Practice II (6 cr.), that anchored the sixth year. The two courses were not required for the program's professional accreditation. ARCH 651 and ARCH 652 were additional courses to the core professional competency coursework undertaken and an opportunity to project into specializations and supportive competencies.
- The four two-credit hour professional practice courses (8 cr.) were consolidated into two three-credit hour professional practice courses (6 cr.), ARCH 673 Professional Practice I and ARCH 674 Professional Practice II.
- ARCH 521 Media Tech VI (2 cr.) and ARCH 522 Media Tech VII (2 cr.) were deleted and content was incorporated into the studio sequence.
- ARCH 551 Architecture Studio IV (6 cr.) and ARCH 561 Building Shop (2 cr.) were deleted and replaced by new courses ARCH 654 Research Studio (5 cr.) and ARCH 654L Research Lab (2 cr.).
- The graduate Topics in Architecture course, ARCH 692, was deleted and a graduate history course, ARCH 544 Professional History (3 cr.) is introduced in its place.
- The graduate elective never resonated with the students nor did a sufficient range of elective opportunities arise at the graduate level.
