Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.

As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major
- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course AHSS 111 (or AIS 211 for teaching specialization students only)
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- 6+ credits of Modern Foreign Language coursework, including completion of the 202-Level

As part of the German major, students in this program must complete 23 Major elective credits and select at least 21 upper-division credits. The following is a suggested sequence.

- Composition and Conversation 3 Credits
 - GER 330 Reading and Writing for Communication 3 Credits
- Language and Professional Skills Electives (minimum 1 from this section)
 - GER 330 Reading And Writing for Communication 3 Credits
 - GER 350 German for Commerce 3 Credits
 - o GER 444 German Culture and Language Translation 3 Credits
 - o GER 492 Topics (when topic is advanced language or professional skills) 2-3 Credits
 - GER 494 Internship 1-3 Credits
 - GER 496 Field Experience 1-6 Credits
- Literature Culture and Civilization Electives (minimum 1 from this section)
 - GER 353 Introduction to German Literature 3 Credits
 - GER 380 Deutschland Heute 3 Credits
 - o GER 435 German Cultural History 3 Credits
 - GER 454 Survey of German Literature II 3 Credits
 - GER 455 German Film 3 Credits
 - GER 392 & 492 Topics 2-3 Credits (when topics is literature cultures and/or civilization)
 - Additional credits from travel or field experience
 - o All majors are strongly encouraged to study abroad in a German-speaking country in order to complete elective credits.
