Comments/Notes

Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.

As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major
- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course AHSS 111 (or AIS 211 for teaching specializations students only)
- a minor, second major, or teaching certification

As part of the Theatre major, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a "C" or better in each major course (THEA)
- activities credits each semester to participate in theatre productions.
 - o first and second year take at least four activities credits in THEA 135/145 & DANC 135
 - o third and fourth year take at least four activities credits in THEA 336/346 & DANC 336
 - o a total of four are required: one acting credit, one technical credit, and one dance credit required
 - o the fourth can be either acting or technical.
- at least 3 credits of THEA 480 Summer Theatre; it can be taken any summer or substituted for an internship.

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
