7. Explanation of the Change:

HO 311-311L Herbaceous Plants & Lab (3 cr.) has been moved from Supporting Coursework to the Technical Electives section. This change to the curriculum strengthens students' ability to craft and develop their personal scholastic interests, in keeping with Landscape Architecture accreditation standards and needs. HO 311-311L is a special-interest course for landscape architecture students and is more appropriate as an option on the technical electives list rather than as a requirement for all students.
