

Brookings County Vaccine Status

GROUP 1A



POPULATION: Healthcare providers working on the frontlines in both hospitals and long-term care facilities.

STATUS: Have received both vaccine doses.

GROUP 1B



POPULATION: Long-term care residents in nursing homes and assisted living facilities.

STATUS: Has received first dose of vaccine and many have already received their second dose.

GROUP 1C



POPULATION: Other healthcare workers, public health workers, emergency medical services, law enforcement and correctional officers.

STATUS: Many have already received their first vaccine dose but are awaiting their second dose.

GROUP 1D



POPULATION: Persons with 2 or more underlying medical conditions, educators, persons age 65+, residents in congregate settings and funeral service workers.

STATUS: 7,500+ people in Brookings County. Currently contacting individuals 80+ years of age; high-risk individuals (2+ underlying medical conditions); and people living in a congregate setting.

GROUP 1E



POPULATION: Fire service personnel and other critical infrastructure workers.

STATUS: Priority will depend on number of vaccine doses allocated per week. The Department of Health estimates **APRIL** at the earliest to vaccinate this group.

PHASE 2



POPULATION: All others 16+

STATUS: Department of Health estimates **MAY** at the earliest to vaccinate this group.
