7. Explanation of the Change:

The Consumer Science Department requirements have been incorporated into the major requirements. The Department has removed the cross-listing option for LMNO/LDR 410 Leadership: Senior Seminar (3 cr.) and LMNO/LDR 435 Organizational Leadership and Team Development (3 cr.). In addition, the number of internship hours to complete certification through the Nonprofit Leadership Alliance in nonprofit management has been revised from 300 hours to 120 hours (minimum).
