As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major

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- a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course – AHSS 111 (or AIS 211 for teaching specializations students only)
- a minor, second major, or teaching certification

As part of the Theatre major, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a “C” or better in each major course (THEA)
- activities credits each semester to participate in theatre productions.
 - first and second year take at least four activities credits in THEA 135/145 & DANC 135
 - third and fourth year take at least four activities credits in THEA 336/346 & DANC 336
 - a total of four are required: one acting credit, one technical credit, and one dance credit required
 - the fourth can be either acting or technical.
- at least 3 credits of THEA 480 – Summer Theatre; it can be taken any summer or substituted for an internship.

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
