Early Childhood Education Notes

- A grade of "C" or better is required in PSYC 101, ENGL 101, CMST 101, MATH 114/103, and all major courses with an EDFN, HDFS or ECE prefix. An overall GPA of 2.5 is required to enroll in any education courses.
- Students must meet all GPA Requirements (2.6 for graduation, 2.8 in major courses including ECE, HDFS, and EDFN) and be accepted into the ECE Teacher Education program.
- Students will be required to pass the PRAXIS content and Principles of Teaching and Learning exams to be eligible for teacher certification/educator licensing.
- At beginning of graduation semester, a graduation application must be completed.
