As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 6 credits of Modern Foreign Language including the 202 level\*
- AHSS 111 (or AIS 211 for teaching specializations students only),
- A minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses),
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization, and
- a designated capstone course in their major

Students interested in the Interdisciplinary Studies major must have a goal-based plan of study approved by the end of their first semester in the program. The plan must include 50% upper division credits. Prior credit may apply.

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
