8. Explanation of the Change:

Removed a specific course selection from SGR #1 and SGR #2 to allow students more flexibility in meeting their System General Education requirements.

The College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences has eliminated the college requirement to complete 11 credits from the Group 1 list. AS 101-101L Introduction to Animal Science and Lab (3,1 cr.) and PS 103-103L Crop Production and Lab (2, 1 cr.) fulfilled the college requirement and major requirements.

In addition, departments have updated zero credit lab courses. Departments have adjusted the credits between the lecture and labs to accurately reflect contact time.
