SDSU is also requesting permission to offer BADM 459 Analytics, a common course currently offered by BHSU and NSU. It will also be offered as an elective class for our Accounting minor students. As you may be aware, SDSU business students take STAT 281 Introduction to Statistics instead of BADM 220 Business Statistics. As such, we are also requesting a course modification for BADM 459 to allow either BADM 220 or STAT/MATH 281 as the prerequisite for the course. There is precedent for this pre-requisite choice in BADM 321 Business Statistics II and other common business courses.
