## Comments/Notes

The Accelerated Option is for students who have completed a Baccalaureate Degree in any field and wish to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Exceptions may be made to previous Bachelor under certain circumstances. The program is completed in 12 months and begins once a year (August) in Sioux Falls and once a year (January) in Aberdeen and Rapid City.

To be considered for admissions, students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.700 or higher. The College of Nursing also requires a grade of "C" or higher in all coursework applied toward graduation. Meeting minimum qualifications does not guarantee acceptance into the Nursing major. Students are selected competitively based on experiences, attributes, and metrics. Admission criteria may include academic score, personal statements, personal references, and an interview with the Admissions Committee.

Students may apply while prerequisite (Pre-Nursing) courses are in progress. However, of the eight (8) pre-nursing courses, four (4) must be complete with at least two (2) of the remaining four (4) in progress at the time of application for Rapid City and Aberdeen (June application / January start); and five (5) of the eight (8) pre-nursing courses must be complete with two (2) of remaining three (3) in progress for Sioux Falls (January application / August start).

\*Pre-nursing courses (determine pre-nursing GPA): CHEM 106/106L or 112/112L; MICR 231/231L; BIOL 221/221L, 325/325L; PSYC 101; NUTR 315; HDFS 210; one of the following: SOC 100, 150, or 240 or ANTH 210.
