8. Explanation of the Change:

The School of Education, Counseling and Human Development reviewed the Family and Consumer Sciences Education major. The department removed ECE 496 Field Experience (1 cr.) from the program requirements. The Early Childhood Education program no longer requires the course for their degree program and a decision has been made to embed 15 hours of ECE related experience into the EDFN 453L Teaching & Learning III Lab to streamline the process for students and ECE faculty. Removal of ECE 496 (1 credit), changed the total number of hours required for the major from 83-84 to 82-83 and increased the minimum required electives from 2-3 credits to 3-4 credits.
