1. Provide specific reasons for the proposal of this course and explain how the changes enhance the curriculum.

This course will include practicum hours only for the Post-Graduate Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner Certificate student. This change will aid in clarity for registration and workload assignments. Additionally, by allowing variable (1-9) credits for the practicum, students can determine how many credit hours are feasible to accomplish within one semester. Nine credits are required to complete the program so if a student takes more clinical hours per semester, they can shorten their plan of study; however, if a student needs to take fewer credit hours per semester, they can lengthen their plan of study. This change allows students to continue working while completing their post-graduate certificate. Students will work with their advisor and the APRN Program Director to determine how many credits they take each semester. They have to complete 9 credits, however, the credits they elect to take may depend on their own individualized needs.
