





Tutorial for Submitting a Modification for review by the SDSU IRB in Cayuse




Dashboard view of Cayuse Human Ethics module. To modify an approved study, select the study from the My Studies menu







Select which type of modification you would like to make. You can select more than one modification.




For each modification or amendment to the study, provide a justification. Select [Save] after each change.




Once compliance statement is completed, select the menu that corresponds to the modification that was selected in the first screen. In that example, changes to study procedures and changes to informed consent were selected.






Remember to select save.

[Complete Submission]







After certifying, the Submission Details screen appears. It is awaiting authorization.

If you select proceed, the following error message pops up indicating the IRB analyst needs to be assigned and application reviewed.

Your supervisor will also receive an email to certify/approve of the modification.





During the pre-review process, the IRB analyst will determine the level of review required. Since the initial application was an expedited review, the modification will more than likely require an expedited review.

Key Principal Investigator Responsibilities:

- Submit any proposed changes to the Study prior to being implemented via a Modification submission for IRB review and approval.
- Promptly notify the IRB, via Incident submission, of any reportable events (adverse events/protocol deviations/unanticipated problems/subject complaints/etc.) that occur during the research, including any breach in confidentiality or data security that places participants or others at a greater risk of harm.
- Submit a Renewal Submission in advance month of Administrative Check-in or Study Expiration dates to allow for IRB review and approval to continue conducting study activities.

Once review is complete, you will receive an email notifying you of the determination.
