Good afternoon Daluss.

There is a history course common only to BHSU and SDSU in the inventory, HIST 419/519 World Environmental History, in which we are interested in altering the course description. The current description is: **Examines the history of interactions between human cultures and the natural world, from early humans to the present day.** Our proposed revision would be worded as follows: Examines the history of interactions between human cultures and the natural world *from the 1400s to the present day.* Our justification is as follows:

The proposed revision is more in alignment with the HIST 111/112 and HIST 121/122 sequences. Additionally, reducing the content focus of the course to the period from the age of European colonialism to the modern world better aligns it with the focus of the B.A. in Global Studies and the expertise of the instructor.

Our history coordinator, Dale Potts, has taught this and the Environmental History of the US course several times; his scholarship is in environmental history. Would you all be supportive of this change or have any objections?
