8. Explanation of the Change:

The School of Education, Counseling and Human Development has removed a specific course selection from SGR #1, SGR #2, and SGR #5 to allow students more flexibility in meeting their System General Education requirements.

Black Hills State University has requested increasing SPED 485 Special Education Law from 2 to 3 credits. The increase in credits has been requested because of difficulty in providing enough information for educators to be successful in knowing and applying the law within their work with the 2-credit option. The SDSU Education taskforce agrees that the increase in credits is needed and supports program learning outcomes and accreditation standards. The B.S. in Special Education will decrease in electives by 1 credit to support the increase in credits of SPED 485 to 3 credits.
