Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.
As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major
- a grade of C or better is required in SGR \#2 Oral Communication, ENGL 101, SGR \#5 Mathematics, and in all education coursework
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- $10+$ credits in Natural Sciences including two lab science courses and courses in at least two prefixes.
- a "C" or better in in major coursework

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
