As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in the major
- a minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- a "C" or better in each major course
- $10+$ credits in Natural Sciences including two lab science courses and courses in at least two prefixes
