COMMENTS/NOTES

Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.

An overall GPA of 2.5 is required to enroll in any education courses.

As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- a capstone course in their major
- minor, second major, or teaching specialization
- a grade of C or better is required for all courses in the major
- 10 + credits in Natural Sciences including two lab science courses and courses in at least two prefixes

As part of the History major, students in this program must complete:

- 6 credits of 300-400 level U.S. History,
- 6 credits of 300-400 level World History, and
- 6 additional credits of 300-400 level History from the US or World History Electives list.
- US History Electives
 - HIST 349, 352, 357, 358, 367, 368, 373, 378, 409, 455, 460, 462, 465, 471, 476,
 - HIST 494 Internship (max 3 credits)**
 - GEOG 372-372L, GEOG 383-383L, 405
- World History Electives
 - HIST 301, 326, 341, 381, 401, 402, 404, 406, 415, 422, 425, 440, 445,
 - HIST 494 Internship (max 3 credits)**
 - POLS 447, 458
- **Approved internship credits (HIST 494) taken in another country or focused on a World History (non-US) subject will count as upper-level World History Elective credits; approved internship credits taken in the US and focused on US history will count as upper-level US History Elective credits.
- A maximum of 6 credits from a non-History prefix will be accepted towards the upper-level elective requirements.

Testing into a higher-level language course may reduce time to graduation.
