Students from all academic majors can pursue graduation with Fishback Honors College distinction. View the Honors program requirements.

The College of Nursing admits students into the Standard Option nursing major every Fall and Spring semester in Brookings and Rapid City, and every Spring semester in Sioux Falls. Students are eligible to apply to the Nursing major while they are in progress with their final pre-nursing courses. To be considered for admission, students must have pre-nursing* and cumulative GPAs of 2.700 or higher. The College of Nursing also requires a grade of "C" or higher in all coursework applied toward graduation. Meeting the minimum qualifications does not guarantee a candidate acceptance into the Nursing major. Students are selected competitively based on academic metrics; criteria may also include experiences and attributes. The Standard Option nursing major is completed in five (5) semesters.

*Pre-nursing courses (determine pre-nursing GPA): CHEM 106/106L or 112/112L; MICR 231/231L; BIOL 221/221L, 325/325L; PSYC 101; NUTR 315; HDFS 210; one of the following: SOC 100, 150, or 240 or ANTH 210.
