The RN to B.S.N. program at South Dakota State University is a fully online, flexible, and affordable option designed to provide a pathway for associate and diploma RNs to enhance their professional Nursing career. The RN to B.S.N. program is designed so that RNs can determine the pace of degree completion. All coursework is available online and the curriculum is designed with the working RN in mind. The program offers a total of six (6) sessions that students can enroll in and each course in the program is offered a minimum of three (3) times per year. In addition, each session has a corresponding application deadline to start (as noted in the table below):
