8. Explanation of the Change:

The School of Health and Human Sciences has requested to change the name of the *Sport and Recreation Administration* program to *Sport Management*. The Sport and Recreation Administration (M.S.) program has changed to accommodate a larger focus on sport management vs outdoor and park recreation courses previously provided. Since the sport and recreation administration program focus and curriculum has shifted, the Sport and Recreation Administration master’s requires a name change to reflect the shift in program focus from outdoor/park recreation to sport management. The name change was also recommended by the program’s external reviewers in the spring 2024 Institutional Program Review (IPR).
