8. Explanation of the Change:

The School of Health and Human Sciences has requested to change the name of the *Sport and Recreation Management* program to *Sport Management*. The Sport and Recreation Management (B.S.) program updated its curriculum for the 2023-2024 academic year to accommodate a larger focus on sport management vs outdoor and park recreation courses previously provided. Since the sport & recreation program focus and curriculum has shifted, the Sport and Recreation Management major requires a name change to reflect the shift in program focus from outdoor/park recreation to sport management. The name change was also recommended by the program’s external reviewers in the spring 2024 Institutional Program Review (IPR).

Three credits from SGR #3 have changed to SGR electives to allow for more student choice.
