



**5. TERMINATION WITH ENROLLED STUDENTS**

**a. Provide a justification for terminating the program:**

The College of Nursing requests to terminate the Post-Graduate Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate. The request to terminate the post-graduate certificate is based on low program enrollment. One student has completed the certificate in the last 5 years.

**b. What is the plan for completion of the program by current students?**

Students enrolled in the Post-Graduate Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate will be allowed to continue with their current plan of study. SDSU currently has three (3) students enrolled in the post-graduate certificate. All students are anticipated to graduate no later than summer 2028.

**c. What is the proposed date (day/month/year) program termination status begins (program status in the database changes to *Phasing Out* and last date a student may enroll in or declare the program)?**

Spring 2025
